The following criteria **must** be met prior to submitting Weighted Admission form. Checking each box below provides the student's acknowledgement that the required steps have been completed.

- \*  Complete Nursing Career Talk. Print/Save completion receipt validating score of 100% and date of completion. Upload receipt to supporting documents section of Weighted Admission form when application is submitted. Failure to provide documentation will result in ineligible application.
- \*  New students must complete the application process to GTC and receive an acceptance letter from the college Admissions Office as the first step. The Nursing Weighted Admission form is supplemental to the GTC application and cannot be submitted without a valid GTC Student ID.  
Students previously accepted to GTC who have not enrolled in courses for three consecutive semesters are considered inactive and must contact the Admissions Office to update their account to an active status. Only active students are eligible for application to the Nursing program.
- \*  Official transcripts from other colleges must be received and evaluated by a GTC Transcript Evaluator if transferring course work from another college. If more than one college was attended, an official transcript must be received from each individual college for evaluation.  
GTC does not always recognize courses at another institution as being wholly equivalent to its own. The transcript evaluation process must be completed prior to submission of this application.  
**Do not attach transcripts to this application.**  
\*If you have not attended college anywhere other than GTC, you may check this box to acknowledge this step does not apply to you.
- \*  Student must verify that grade report records are viewable in Self Service Tool through GTC4me. Grades not posted in the college system at the time of application will **not** be awarded points.
- \*  Successfully complete minimum course work of: ENG 101, MAT 120, PSY 201 with a grade of "C" or higher to be eligible for submission of application.
- \*  Successfully\* complete BIO 210 if taking BIO 210/211 combination; or successfully\* completed BIO 215 or BIO 216 if taking BIO 215/216 combination.  
\*with a grade of "C" or higher within 5 years of the application period  
- Review Career Talk regarding repeated BIO courses, as there are ineligibility rules related to greater than two attempts to achieve a successful BIO course grade.
- \*  Complete the full version of the ATI TEAS® test prior to submitting application.  
If test is not administered through GTC, student must request to have official transcript sent to GTC via the ATI system.  
Minimum score of 65 is required. TEAS test scores are valid for 5 years. Must indicate date of test completion for score provided.  
The required TEAS test must be completed in one session and consists of 170 multiple-choice questions including all areas of Reading, Math, Science, English, and Language Usage. Verification of the correct version is necessary when testing anywhere other than GTC.  
Verify score is viewable in Self Service Tool prior to submitting application.
- \*  Attach copy of state license or national certification as documentation for points in section C for previous health-related education, if applicable.
- \*  Attach documentation on official company letterhead stating required details for employment and/or volunteer experience in healthcare. Documentation must meet criteria outlined in Career Talk to be eligible for points.
