

# HAAS and Bosch Rexroth Scholarships



- Awarded 31 scholarships to manufacturing students for fall 2021
- Awarded 37 scholarships to manufacturing students for spring 2022.

## BAS Program: Curriculum Revisions



- Modified some courses to accelerate program progression for many of our students.
- Increasing use of hybrid courses to make our schedule more flexible and accommodating of student work schedules.
- Enhancing use of prior learning assessment credit for industry experiences.
- Hiring a new laboratory specialist for CMI to support faculty and students, and maintain equipment.

### **BAS** Enrollment



- The program graduated four students in December, 2021.
- 21 Students currently enrolled in the program.
- 8 Students admitted for FA22 and 13 applications in process
- 20 New BAS students expected in FA22

### **GTC Research Grants**



- Awarded two research grants from SCRA totaling \$150,000 over 3 years.
- The Future Factories Grant held a face-to-face meeting in Columbia, SC on Dec 10, 2021:
  - USC and Clemson will represent the OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) companies
  - Midland Tech and Greenville Tech will represent the Tier I companies.
  - Next meeting will be held in February.
