Agency Identification: Greenville Technical College

Describe the nature of the emergency condition and the resulting immediate threat to public health, welfare, critical economy and efficiency, or safety that this procurement responded to: Greenville Technical College's Corporate & Continuing Education division relies on the Modern Campus Lifelong Learning Workforce & Community platform to manage non-credit registration, employer contract training, invoicing, student records, and required state reporting. A lapse in access to this system would immediately disrupt the College's ability to process registrations, fulfill employer contract training agreements, invoice corporate partners, collect revenue, and maintain required workforce reporting. Corporate & Continuing Education operates on a self-supporting revenue model and supports regional employers through contract training and workforce upskilling initiatives. A result in not purchasing this product is a immediate threat of five million dollars of revenue. Interruption of this system would impair the functioning of the College, disrupt contractual commitments to industry partners, and negatively affect workforce development efforts that support the regional economy.

Describe the facts and circumstances giving rise to the above describe emergency condition and threat: The Modern Campus platform was originally implemented during the College's transition to a new ERP system – Anthology. Anthology declared bankruptcy late last year and there was no time to conduct a competitive procurement after our contract with them was not renewed. Modern Campus is now fully embedded in Corporate & Continuing Education daily operations, including enrollment processing, employer billing, data tracking, and state reporting. The current subscription term expires March 1, 2026 . While contract expiration is known, the College cannot conduct and complete a full competitive procurement and system implementation prior to this date without significant operational disruption. Additionally, the South Carolina Technical College System Office is in the final stages of evaluating a potential system-wide solution for corporate and continuing education operations. The system office has an RFP out and is working toward a common data reporting system for CCE units across the state. Conducting a separate institutional procurement at this time would likely result in duplication of effort, increased cost, and potential misalignment with forthcoming statewide direction. Transitioning to an alternative platform prior to renewal would require significant implementation time, data conversion, retraining, and workflow redesign, which cannot be completed before the subscription expiration without interrupting Corporate & Continuing Education operations and employer services. This emergency procurement is limited to the minimum period necessary to maintain operational continuity while statewide direction is finalized or a compliant competitive solicitation can be conducted.

Agency has contracted with or plans to contract with Emergency Vendor for the supplies, services, information technology, or construction described below per S.C. Code Ann. §11-35-1570 and S.C. Regulation 19-445.2110, Emergency Procurement.

Emergency Vendor: Modern Campus, USA Inc.

Basis for Selection of the Vendor –Modern Campus USA Inc. is the incumbent provider under an existing agreement dated February 28, 2023 . Corporate & Continuing Education operations, historical enrollment data, employer contracts, billing workflows, and reporting configurations are fully integrated within this platform. Given the operational reliance on the system and the limited timeframe prior to expiration, no alternative vendor could be competitively procured and implemented without service interruption. The College is limiting this procurement to ensure continuity pending statewide procurement direction or completion of a competitive process.
